Mayor Eberline acknowledged Jeff Carson, GC Municipal Utilities Manager, for an annual department update. Discussion on cause and outcomes from recent power outage; potential to add a fourth generator to our system; update air storage/compressors; boring project for all lines underground in the next five years; and annual audit. No formal action taken.

Smith moved and Rasmussen seconded action on Resolution 2023-12, a resolution to award the bid for the FY23, 24 and 25 annual city audit services. Sawyer explained three bids were received:

Sawyer commented City has had a great relationship with Rachelle K Thompson, CPA over the past five years and T.P Anderson & Company is currently working on first audit for GCMU. Smith commented a second set of eyes looking over the financials for the City is not a bad idea. Mcdonald mentioned staying with current auditor who knows how our City runs, is also beneficial. Smith moved and Rasmussen seconded action to amend the motion to award the contract to Rachelle K Thompson, CPA for FY23, FY24 and FY25. No further discussion, motion carried five ayes.

Rasmussen moved and Smith seconded action on Resolution 2023-13, a resolution to approve the street closures for July 7-9th, 2023 Felix Grundy Days. Discussion on request from Jill Krausman to hold a mimosa and bloody mary bar as to location and fencing. Smith moved and Kuester seconded action to table this resolution until further questions answered. No further discussion, motion carried five ayes.

Mayor Eberline opened the discussion on the Neighborhood Revitalization Grant results. City received notification from Iowa Economic Development Authority that our grant application was not awarded. Items to do before next grant cycle are to collect letters of support from multiple stakeholders; appoint a special committee for project planning; complete the LMI survey; and work with Iowa State University on neighborhood inventory project to understand the conditions within target neighborhood. No further discussion or action taken.

Mayor Eberline opened the discussion on economic development incentives for previous Richelieu Foods property, A Avenue. Eberline mentioned the City was caught completely off guard with news of closing and was not approached prior to announcement. Jeff Kolb, Butler Grundy County Development Director, is assisting all parties with transition and planning a career fair for April 4, 2023 in Grundy Center. No further discussion or action taken.

Mayor Eberline opened the discussion on Sports Complex Concessions Manager position. No applications have been received. Sawyer asked how to proceed. Further advertising when pool jobs are posted soon. No action taken.

Mayor Eberline opened the discussion on the FY2024 annual city budget. Sawyer explained Governor Reynolds sign the bill to correct the residential property tax roll back percentages on February 24,2023. The bill allows County Auditors until March 9, 2023 to resubmit new property tax valuation to the State of Iowa. As of today, Grundy County valuations have not been refiled. Discussions will resume at March 20, 2023 meeting, no action taken.

Mayor Eberline opened the public forum at 7:17pm. Shirley Ahlberg asked of know interest in the Richelieu Foods property. None known at this time. Public forum closed at 7:19pm.

Finance Committee/ Clerk commented upcoming comprehensive task force meeting March 29, 2023.

Public Safety Committee made no comment.

Public Works Committee commented on thank you received from Grundy County Memorial Hospital for pool pass donation for Gala fundraising event; water improvement project is planning to start up again March 20, 2023; and daily water usages are back down to normal levels.

Kuester moved and Rasmussen seconded adjournment of the meeting at 7:25pm. Motion carried five ayes. Next meeting will be Monday, March 20, 2023, at 6:30pm.
