Kuester moved and Smith seconded action on Resolution 2023-55, a resolution authorizing Mayor Eberline to sign an agreement with Grundy County Memorial Hospital. No further discussion, motion carried five ayes.

Smith moved and Mcdonald seconded action on Resolution 2023-56, a resolution recognizing the dedicated years of service for Mike Muller, Street Superintendent and approving a single health insurance package for his retirement. Council thanked Muller for 28 years of service to the community and appreciates everything he's done. No further discussion, motion carried five ayes.

Rasmussen moved and Mcdonald seconded action on Resolution 2023-57, a resolution approving a social media policy for the City of Grundy Center. No further discussion, motion carried five ayes.

Kuester moved and Rasmussen seconded action on Resolution 2023-58, a resolution approving a workplace gambling policy for the employee handbook. No further discussion, motion carried five ayes.

Kuester moved and Rasmussen seconded action on Resolution 2023-59, a resolution to authorize

the advertising of two trucks and two rollers no longer used by the Public Works Department. No further discussion, motion carried five ayes.

Smith moved and McDonald seconded action on Resolution 2023-60, a resolution authorizing the reimbursement of half of the training fees for eligible lifeguards. Reimbursement amounts vary due to full certification or recertification training. No further discussion, motion carried four ayes (Smith, McDonald, Kuester and Rasmussen) and one abstain (Lamp).

Mayor Eberline opened the public forum at 6:43pm. Rich Ahlberg, 403 G Avenue, commented on finance committee accepting low bids on lots that were sold, asked for update on tennis court project, asked who attended the GCMU board meeting, asked once figure 8 races are over if junk vehicles will all leave town, pointed out a dent in city owned grain bins, and commented on used cars parked on front yard of 401 G Avenue. No further comments, public forum closed at 7:00pm.

Finance Committee/Clerk commented on election form and Park Board meeting this week.

Public Safety Committee made no comments.

Public Works Committee commented that Blacktop Services will be finishing up seal coating streets and alleys end of this week; tennis court project; and pool closing end of this week.

Smith moved and Rasmussen seconded adjournment of the meeting at 7:10pm. Motion carried five ayes. Next meeting will be Monday, September 11, 2023, at 6:30pm.
