ORDINANCE NO. 572

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 99 OF THE GRUNDY CENTER CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE MINIMUM CHARGE FOR SANITARY SERWER USE

Be It Ordained By the Council of the City of Grundy Center, Iowa:

- SECTION 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>. The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 99, Section 99.07 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Grundy Center, Iowa, as to Sewer Use Charge.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO MUNICIPAL CODE. Section 99.07 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Grundy Center, Iowa, is hereby amended so as to delete the entire Section and substitute therefore the following:
- 99.07 MINIMUM CHARGE. The minimum charge per month per user shall be \$22.07. The total minimum charge shall be paid by the user responsible for the meter. In addition, each user responsible for a meter (except as provided in Section 99.08) shall pay a user charge rate for operation and maintenance including replacement of \$1.38 per 100 cubic feet of water as determined in the preceding section. For those properties where sump pump connections into the sewer system have been approved by the City pursuant to Section 95.04 (2), there will be an additional monthly charge of \$11.03.
- SECTION 3. <u>REPEALER</u>. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances heretofore enacted by the City Council of the City of Grundy Center, Iowa, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.
- SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY OF PROVISIONS. It is the intention of the City Council that each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable, and if any such provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance or any part thereof other than

that affected by such decision.

SECTION 5. $\underbrace{\text{EFFECTIVE DATE}}_{\text{effect from}}$. This Ordinance shall be in full force and $\underbrace{\text{effect from}}_{\text{publication as provided by law}}$.
